Session 12 - Chapter 14

## **The Triumph of the Gospel**

Why does John now see the Lamb standing on Mt. Zion? What is the significance of this in light of Psalm 2:1-6?

Note here the liturgical quality of verses 1-3. What is the new song about and why can only the 144,000 sing it? (See I Corinthians 2:6-9)

Who participates in this true worship of Christ? What is their character? Why and how? (See Hebrews 9:14, Ephesians 5:26)

Who are the three angels of 6-11? or what do these angels represent?

What comfort do we gain from the first angel? To who else does this angel proclaim the Gospel?

What is Babylon the Great? What has she made the nations do? How is her fall to be viewed in terms of Law and Gospel?

What is the warning of the third angel? How and why do believers in Christ avoid this woe? (See Psalm 75:8, Matthew 26:42)

How do verses 12-13 describe the Christian life and death? How do faith and works fit together in this passage?

What is the meaning of the harvest depicted in verses 14-20? Is this judgment of the nations only or does this include the gathering of the saints? How does this fit with other harvest motifs in the Scriptures? (See Joel 3:13; Matthew 9:37-38, Matthew 13:24-30).
